The PGY2 residency in emergency medicine pharmacy is conducted at **CHRISTUS Mother Frances Hospital - Tyler**, a not-for-profit community health system in East Texas.

## PGY2 Emergency Medicine Pharmacy Residency

The PGY2 Emergency Medicine Pharmacy Residency at **CHRISTUS Mother Frances Hospital - Tyler** is an ASHP-accredited, one-year program focused on enhancing clinical pharmacy skills. Residents gain direct patient care experience under a preceptor and work with interdisciplinary teams in various hospital areas. The program emphasizes evidence-based care and prepares residents for PGY2 opportunities, including pharmacy conferences.

- Curriculum vitae
- Three letters of recommendation
- Selected applicants will be interviewed
