

How to Login/Change Password in CREDIT

These instructions show users how to log into CREDIT and change their password and security question.

Step 1: In your browser navigate to <https://www.ddotscredit.com/IrvingTXChristusHealth>. From this login page you can type in your login and password and click **Log In**. If you do not have a login and password for CREDIT, please email CIIACC@christushealth.org.

Step 3: Scroll down to the section titled **Sign-On and User Access Information**. This is where you can change your password. It's also a good idea to change your security question at this point, since it will have been loaded with a default question and answer. When finished click any **Save & Continue** button.
